HOLIDAYS DURING TERM TIME

In the summer term, the governing body reviewed the school's policy on fines for holidays taken during term time. As from September 1st 2026, parents may request up to a **MAXIMUM OF 5 DAYS** per academic year for holidays. This will be authorised if a pupils attendance is **95% or above at the time of the holiday.**

Please note if parents apply for this, and the pupils' attendance declines before the holiday, taking it below 95%, fines will proceed

FIDGET TOYS AND CUDDLY BEARS

We are experiencing an increasing number of pupils bringing into school fidget toys or cuddly toys. Parents / carers are kindly requested to ensure their child **DOES NOT** bring these items into school. They cause unnecessary distraction and upset when they are removed.

In every classroom we have **ZONES OF REGULATION** that are equipped with age appropriate activities and strategies to support pupils' mental health and emotional well-being. Please contact your child's classteacher if you require further information on how to support your child.

COMMUNICATION

PARENT PAY – please ensure you **DOWNLOAD APP** to order meals every day by 8am. All school meals are **FREE** but still must be ordered.

You will also need this app to book and pay for school trips.

SEESAW – All parents / carers must use this app to access school newsletters and information. We will not be providing printed letters. If you do not access this app, you will not get school information. Teachers will also use Seesaw to communicate with you.

Correspondence to teachers should be between 8.30am and 4.30pm – TERM TIME only.
Staff have been advised not to respond to emails / messages outside of these hours.
