# CLASSES FOR SEPTEMBER 2026

Our **Welcome Wednesday** sessions will take place on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> July. All pupils will register in their own classes. They will then meet in the hall and move to their 'September class' for the day. All pupils will be dismissed from their new classes on these days – parents should meet their child outside the new classes.

We have decided not to hold the **Meet the Teacher meetings** this year as they are poorly attended.

## Classes

### Nursery:

The nursery class is named '**pabi cymreig**' meaning 'Welsh poppy'. Mrs R Jones will be the teacher supported by Miss K Jones and Mrs L Davies.

### Reception:

The reception class is named '**clychau'r gog**' meaning 'Bluebells'. Miss H Richards is the teacher supported by Mrs C King.

### Year 1:

This class will be named '**dosbarth eirllys**' meaning 'snowdrop'. Mrs C Davies will be the class-teacher, supported by Mrs J Hughes.

### Year 2:

This class will be named '**dosbarth cennin pedr**' after the daffodil flower. Mrs K Jones will be the teacher, supported by Mrs G Henwood.

### Year 3:

This class will be named '**dosbarth celyn**' meaning 'Holly'. Mrs H Jackin will be the teacher.

### Year 4:

This class will be named '**dosbarth onnen**' meaning 'ash'. Mr M Mee will be the teacher.

### Year 5:

This class will be called '**dosbarth helyg**' meaning 'willow'. Mrs James will be the teacher.

### Year 6:

This class will be called '**dosbarth derwen**' meaning 'oak'. Mrs R Harris (previously Evans) will be the teacher. Miss O'Brien will also support Year 6 class.
